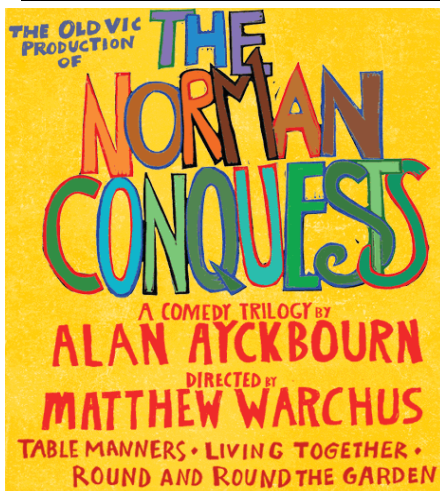

Tom is Chairman of the Board for the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center and theater production company **Scorpio Entertainment**. Currently: *The Norman Conquests* (nominated for 7 Tony Awards) and *Stomp*. Previously: *Gypsy, Hairspray, Young Frankenstein, The Producers, Sweeney Todd, Company, Little Shop of Horrors, The Weird, The Sound of Music, Smokey Joe's Cafe, Angels in America, Oleanna, Love Letters, Driving Miss Daisy, Frankie and Johnny in the Clair de Lune, Penn and Teller* and many others. Their shows have been awarded 35 Tony Awards, 46 Drama Desk Awards, 37 Outer Critics Awards, four Grammys, eight Olivier Awards and two Pulitzer Prizes.
