What is Shrove Tuesday and why pancakes?

Shrove Tuesday, or Pancake Day, is a traditional British celebration taking place the night before Lent. In preparation for the fast during Lent, butter, eggs, and milk had to be used up as they were prohibited during the fast.

A delicious way to do this was to make thin crepe like pancakes

Which were traditionally eaten as the last indulgence before the fast.

Activities evolved from this practice including pancake races and pancake tossing contests.
